Length of Evaluations:

The length of an evaluation will vary, depending on the nature of the evaluation. Typically, it is between 2 to 6 hours of direct contact time, over 1 to 3 testing sessions.

Initial Consultation \$190

The purpose of this 50-minute meeting is to discuss your concerns and collect a detailed history of the issue. This may include recommendations for testing, if appropriate, and referrals to other professionals, as needed.

Second Opinion Consultation \$190

This 50-minute session includes a review of educational and psychological records to provide a second opinion regarding previous clinical or school testing and whether more or different testing is needed.

Rate for Testing, Report and Feedback Sessions \$190/hour



"Catch Kids Before They Fail" Assessment \$350

These assessments are sensitive to early detection of future reading problems in children ages 5 and up. If emerging weaknesses are discovered, interventions can be tailored for an individual education plan. Delays can be minimized or eliminated with early intervention.

Targeted ADHD Evaluation \$800-900

This evaluation includes a consultation to gather developmental, learning and psychosocial histories, analysis of behavior ratings from parents and teachers, and the evaluation of cognitive and behavioral factors associated with ADHD and Executive Functioning issues. More comprehensive testing may be recommended for those with multiple learning challenges. Includes initial consultation, testing, scoring, analysis, follow-up appointment and written report.

Targeted Dyslexia Testing \$800-900

This assessment determines reasons that a child or adult struggles with reading and spelling and provides recommendations to parents and school(s) to improve reading skills. It evaluates reading and spelling skills and pinpoints factors such as phonological processing, vocabulary, listening ability and working memory that affect those skills. More comprehensive testing may be recommended for those with multiple learning challenges. Includes initial consultation, testing, scoring, analysis, follow-up appointment and written report.

Comprehensive Testing for Complex Learning and/or Attention Problems \$1400-1700

This assessment helps determine why a student is struggling and provides recommendations for appropriate remedial activities for school, college or test taking, including ACT and SAT accommodations. This assessment evaluates the full range of cognitive and learning strengths and weaknesses, as well as reading, writing and math skills. Includes initial consultation, testing, scoring, analysis, follow-up appointment and written report.



IQ or Academic Achievement Testing \$400

This measures overall strengths, uncovers hidden weaknesses and provides educational recommendations and strategies. Includes testing, scoring, analysis, 30-minute follow-up interview by phone or in-person and written report.
