Class will cover use of iPads, disposable film camera/SLR, DSLR and preparing for exhibition at the Winter Program. Skills will include building a visual vocabulary, concepts, compositions, and image editing, through basic instruction, demonstration or visual examples. We will shoot outdoors as much as weather permits.
