In 1997, M. Vanci Stirnemann, a Swiss artist, created 1200 2.5" x 3.5" cards by hand as part of an exhibit. On the last day, he invited others to create their own cards and trade with him during the closing reception. Artist trading cards (ATCs) are miniature pieces of art that are traded around the world. Artists will develop their drawing skills and can create, trade and collect the sets they will make using Sharpies, watercolor, and a variety of other materials.
